As a skilled gemcutter, Silvia cuts, shapes, and polishes minerals and stones. Her craft has been her ruling passion for almost fifteen years and is one of the oldest in the world. From raw material to finished design, blending manual work and artistic creation, she crafts New Caledonian minerals and woods in her hidden studio to create a range of pieces: jewellery, paperweights, gold and jade trinkets, serpentine penholders, pendants made from ancient clam shells...

Green, black, grey, red, yellow, brown and blue, veined, speckled, soft or hard... Silvia's inspired skill brings out the hidden beauties of rock and stone. With infinite patience, she shapes and polishes, transforming minerals into timelessly beautiful objects and jewellery. Silvia has shown her artworks and jewellery in many galleries to public acclaim: delicate harmonies of wood and stone, organic sculptures, creations of subtle sensitivity.
