







CRAFT/PROFESSION

Jean KACIREK set up his company Brouss' Art Gravure in November 2018, with the creation and engraving of a range of wooden items as his main activity. Everything Jean markets is made by hand in his studio (magnets, key holders, chopping boards, coasters, wall clocks and bottle openers, to name but a few).

BROUSS' ART GRAVURE

The wood must first be cut to the required size and shaped, planed and sanded. Jean creates a variety of templates (designs and motifs) as models for his delicately carved embellishments. He then sets up his laser engraving machine and executes the design.

When he has completed the engraving, he treats the wood and adds a protective wax polish finish.



BACKGROUND

Jean began crafting wooden items as a hobby and ended up launching his own company. Brouss'Art Gravure owes its existence to a series of coincidences. One day, while browsing the internet, he chanced upon a machine for creating engravings on wood. The idea appealed to him and he decided to buy the machine. Pleased with the first results he achieved, Jean felt encouraged to test the potential of his new craft. He drew great satisfaction from the first items he engraved and gradually honed his skills and perfected his designs.

Jean showed his hand crafted creations for the first time at a garage sale in Bourail.

People visiting the sale were delighted by his designs and Jean decided to devote more time to his craft.
