CRAFT/PROFESSION

Karine AIMÉ paints on fabric. She uses neutral fabric as a background for her painted designs and creates sarongs, apparel for men, women and children and table linen.

Karine makes a pattern to cut out the outfit before assembling and stitching the model together. The finished garment is then washed and dried and is ready for decoration by hand. Karine uses various techniques, including dyeing, freehand painting, stencilling, screen printing and airbrushing... the final phase involves using heat to fix the pigments.

BACKGROUND

Since childhood, Karine has loved transforming objects through the use of shapes and colours and she taught herself all the technical skills she needed for her craft.

INSPIRATION AND ART/DESIGNS

Karine devotes immense care and imagination to the composition of aesthetically pleasing designs based on harmonies between pastel or bright colours, and she loves balancing transparent and opaque textures. She draws inspiration for her designs from the natural world, plants, flowers and wildlife. Karine works mainly with cotton materials.

She says that "love, my raw materials, my emotions, sharing, gentleness and finding peace" are the guiding threads running through her work.
