CRAFT/PROFESSION

Cindy BADIN set up her own craft soap-making business, and creates beauty care and household products from locally produced natural ingredients such as honey, beeswax and oil distilled from candlenut, tamanu and niaouli trees.

She uses a traditional cold saponification method to create her soaps, blending her essential plant oils with caustic soda. She then pours the mixture into moulds and leaves it to settle for 48 hours. Finally, the individual soaps are removed from the moulds and left to rest for another 6 weeks before being ready for sale.

BACKGROUND

Convinced that many products in daily use pose a threat to nature and to our health, Cindy became fascinated by the potential of natural soap-making techniques. She approached independent soap makers based all over the world to ask them for tips and techniques and gradually became expert in craft soap-making.

Cindy's "zero waste" principles and
