Carine BARBERO and Sandra MIOMANDRE design and make furniture and ornamental items using wooden slats.



They offer customers three product lines: “Indoors”, “Garden” and “Deco”. All their designs are custom-made.

Their first task is to collect and salvage wooden pallets and dismantle them.

Carine and Sandra then discuss details and requirements with their customers before designing and crafting the furniture and/or items using hand and power tools.



## BACKGROUND

The two young women are both self-taught and have always loved working with wood. “We first thought of making furniture from wooden slats because we needed to furnish our homes; we were committed to using



salvaged materials but we wanted to create something stylish”, they explain.

## INSPIRATION AND ART/DESIGNS

Armchairs, benches, bedsteads, settles, tables, flower boxes, desks, composting bins, stools, chests... the possibilities are endless.

Practicality is the first design priority for the two partners. They draw their inspiration from everything around them and from their raw material: the shapes and colours of the pallets and slats, and the way the wood is grooved.
