Gwenola LEGRUMELEC handcrafts decorative articles, using her technical skills to engrave and sculpt glass and eggs (ostrich, duck, emu, rhea and goose eggs...).



She designs a wide range of items, including lamps, hangings and candlesticks. Her designs are all original pieces and can be customised on request. Gwenola's designs are exquisitely delicate so her craft requires great precision and attention to detail.



BACKGROUND

Gwenola says her ever-curious nature led her to teach herself her craft. She loved drawing and painting and, aged 13, discovered Ukrainian Pysanky (decorated Easter eggs). Fascinated, and having the fortune to live near an ostrich farm, she began painting on eggs.

Later on, Gwenola spent time in Africa where she met up with artists working in metal artwork and carving, leading her to diversify and develop her work. She was then also making ethnic-style lamps using a wide variety of materials. Once settled in New Caledonia, Gwenola established her brand and infused her designs with traditional local motifs.
