Clothilde WALA is an expert weaver. She weaves her designs using slender supple lengths of plant material, mainly coconut palm and pandanus leaves. She removes the midribs from the leaves to make them more flexible.

Clothilde also creates jewellery from seeds gathered on her island and seashells found on Mouli beach in the south of Ouvéa.
