• BACKGROUND



As a little girl, Caroline used to undress her dolls and give them new outfits made with fabrics borrowed from her mother and a stapler. As she grew older, she began sewing her own clothes when she couldn't afford to buy new clothes or couldn't find anything to please her in the shops.



Caroline studied history at university before switching to applied arts. She began work as a window dresser (designing decors and displays) then taught design and applied arts for 15 years.
