## CRAFT/PROFESSION

Daniel MARTINI designs pens, decorative tabletop objects and a variety of ornamental items. All are handcrafted in Daniel's workshop in Païta. His pens have a delightful feel, blending carefully selected types of rare wood with subtle ornamentation in precious materials such as mother-of-pearl, giant clam shell, semi-precious stones and minerals like garnierite and serpentine... Daniel uses various tools to craft his designs: a wood lathe, a milling machine, laser engraving, gemcutting tools and sometimes a 3D printer.

He sources his wood from pruning cuts and sometimes uses wood recovered from old furniture. Trained as a metal worker, his professional life took him away from his first love but today Daniel is happy to say: "I've been lucky enough to return to it".

## INSPIRATION AND ART/DESIGNS

Daniel draws his inspiration from the materials he works with: their feel, colour, shape and unique properties... the delicate veining of a piece of wood, the soft touch of leather, the sheen of mother-of-pearl and the translucence of gemstones
