CRAFT/PROFESSION

Jeff paints on fabric. Sunshine and vibrant colours are his inspiration, and his creative tools are varying types of fine and broad brushes, a range of dyes and sewing machines.

He buys white fabrics which he transforms by cutting, sewing, dying and painting, and white fabric items which he dyes and/or paints. Jeff works with fabrics in a range of fibres, including cotton, cotton voile, artificial silk and cotton poplin, dying them in shades of pastel.



BACKGROUND

He is self-taught and also learned his skills from members of his family.



INSPIRATION AND ART/DESIGNS

Jeff creates sarongs, each with a different design, in a range of regular and smaller sizes.

He also creates long and short kimonos, aprons and scarves in pastel shades or contrasting colours, decorating them with painted hibiscus flowers or tribal designs.

His colourful range includes items such as tee shirts, dresses, skirts and shorts which are dyed and embellished with stencilled designs.
