Khwangai PINKAEW is an expert weaver and crafts designs reflecting her cultural heritage. She makes hanging mobiles adorned with pandanus and seashells, necklaces fashioned from seeds and little shells and sand paintings decorated with Kanak symbols, kagus, sea turtles and warriors.

Her key speciality is weaving with natural fibres to create magnificent crowns, hanging mobiles, braids and ornaments.

Through the woven designs she crafts, Khwangai shares her passion and dedication and conjures up a world of rich cultural traditions.
