Laurence TARPINIAN is based in Koné, where she designs and makes princess dresses, fancy dress outfits. communion confirmation dresses for young girls and wedding and evening dresses for women. Every one of her designs is a unique, made-tomeasure creation, often hand-embellished with flowers, beads, embroidery and brilliants. Laurence first sketches her design and creates the pattern to cut out the outfit; she then sews the pieces together to create the finished garment. Her sewing machine and overseamer purr softly in the background as each satin and tulle creation takes magic shape.

Laurence learned her skills as a teenager from her expert seamstress mother, and has always designed and made her own clothes.

She published photos of her designs on her Facebook page and got a lot of very positive feedback. Orders began to flow in from Polynesia, Wallis and, of course, New Caledonia.
