Caroline DUPIN GILET has worked as a fashion designer since 2003, creating and making garments for everyday wear and made-to-measure cocktail and wedding dresses. She also designs trousers, jackets and ties for men, and skirts, tops, dresses and trousers for women, not to mention wedding veils and accessories.

She masters every stage of the design process, sketching the model, creating the pattern, cutting out, stitching the garment together and adding the finishing touches: each garment is unique, designed to reflect her customer's tastes, figure and chosen theme.

BACKGROUND

Caroline has a BTS diploma in soft fabrics and is a graduate of a Design & Styling School in Bordeaux. She gained experience working in mid-range ready-to-wear fashion in Paris, then as head designer in high-end ready-to-wear.

In 2016, Caroline was awarded the Title of Master Artisan in her profession, in recognition of her experience and the extensive skills she had acquired through training.

INSPIRATION AND ART/DESIGNS

Caroline's designs are often elegant, sophisticated and ultra feminine.

Her studio-workshop is filled with fabrics she has selected from renowned French and Italian manufacturers: taffeta, shantung silk, crepe, lace...
