- CRAFT/PROFESSION

Eliane TAORA designs Tahitian pearl jewellery.

She uses a precision machine to pierce, polish and cut the pearls, then she fits them onto silver, yellow (18 carat) or white gold findings or threads them onto leather or rubber cords or transparent fishing line.



- BACKGROUND

Eliane has been designing jewellery for 25 years.

She spent many years gaining experience in her craft, working with Tahitian jewellers and on a pearl farm in Rangiroa, the largest atoll in the Tuamotu Islands

She is now a self-employed jewellery designer.
